

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 835**

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 830 was issued on February 25, 2000, declaring a statewide ban of all outdoor open burning. Said Order was issued due to drought conditions that caused and threatened to cause severe wildfire and forest fire conditions over wide areas of Mississippi; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Mississippi is no longer adversely affected by the threat of extreme wildfire and forest fire conditions, due to ample rainfall which has occurred throughout the state;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Law of this State, do hereby declare and order that said Executive Order No. 830 is hereby rescinded.

I authorize and direct the State Forestry Commission and the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency, upon receipt of this Executive Order, to be noticed and be governed accordingly.
