Subject: Wesley Granger: Hockey Arena

Mr. Granger called 4/27 to voice his concern over the Fair Commission's potential to lose the hockey arena due to parking. He says that parking was one of the reasons the Bandits wanted a new arena due to a lack of parking for games and not even being able to play games during the rodeo and the fair. He said that the arena will be an economic boost to the entire metro area and it should be centrally located in Jackson, not in Clinton.
