I am writing to ask assistance to use more wood fence post on Mississippi highway right of ways. Over the last few years' steel live post have taken over largely because of the influence of the steel industry. MSDOT has told me in the past that wood post out perform steel because they take the wear and tear better of highway right of way maintenance.
